

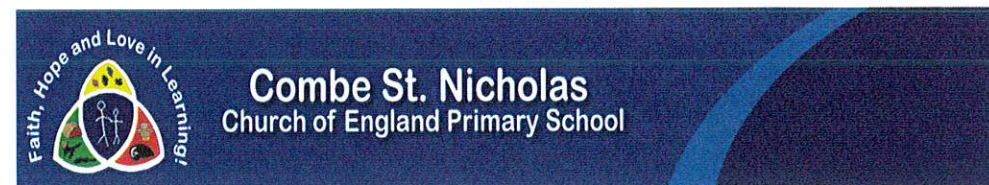

The school will:

- * Care for your child's safety and happiness within a Christian Community
- * Deliver a balanced and carefully planned curriculum which meets the needs of your individual child
- * Encourage your child to meet his/her full potential as a valued member of the school community
- * Provide a range of extra-curricular activities designed to enrich your child's experience
- * Set, mark and monitor home learning, where appropriate
- * Aim to achieve high standards of learning and behaviour through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility
- * Be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the life of the school
- * Make arrangements for teaching staff to discuss any parental concerns at an agreed time
- * Keep you informed about school matters on a regular basis and about your child's progress
- * Make available Complaints Procedure and Guidance, together with Complaints Policy on the school website
- * Ensure safeguarding procedures are followed

Parents/Carers

I/We undertake to:

- * See that my child goes to school regularly, on time and correctly dressed and equipped in accordance with the Combe St Nicholas Primary School Pathway
- * Ensure that my child is collected promptly at the end of the school day and inform school if a different adult, not named on the Data Collection Sheet, is collecting
- * Make the school aware, by contacting the class teacher, of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour
- * Support the school's Policies and Guidelines for Behaviour, Anti-Bullying and Data Protection which can be found on the website
- * Support my child in home learning and other opportunities for home-learning, ensuring that it is satisfactorily completed and returned on the due day
- * Ensure that my child goes to bed at a reasonable time on weekdays
- * Attend Parents' Evenings or ensure regular discussion about my child's progress at school
- * Contact the school as soon as possible if my child is going to be absent for any reason
- * Maintain commitment to the school and support school activities where possible
- * Return books, cups and badges as required or pay for replacements
- * Refer to the weekly newsletter available on the school website for dates, events, changes and policies
- * Support the school with regard to safe use of ICT
